## **Reassessment Agreement**

## This document is to serve as an agreement between the student, parent/guardian, and teacher.

## Reassessment Policies

- If a student scores below and 85% on a unit assessment, he/she will be given the opportunity to be reassessed on those objectives where the learning goals were not met.
- Students must turn in this signed document, and schedule a time for reassessment within five school days of receiving the score on their original unit assessment.
- The grade on the reassessment will be recorded as the final grade for that individual unit assessment. According to school policy, the final recorded grade for the assessment will be capped at a maximum of 85%.

## Reassessment Eligibility

In order to be eligible for reassessment, students must:

- 1. complete and submit high-quality corrections to all errors on unit quizzes by the time of the original unit assessment
- 2. complete any focused review assignments provided to the student during remediation
- 3. work with a general science teacher outside of the normal class period (e.g. period five, before school, after school)
